



What is a vasectomy?

Vasectomies are a form of male birth control which prevent a man from being able to get a woman pregnant. A vasectomy is a procedure that can be done at a physician's office or in the hospital to permanently stop sperm from being released into semen. If a man has a vasectomy, he will still ejaculate during sex, but his semen will not contain any sperm. To make sure that the vasectomy procedure was successful, a semen analysis is done 8-16 weeks after the procedure to make sure it worked.

Who performs a vasectomy?

A vasectomy is most often performed by a clinician with training in these procedures. They can be urologists, family medicine doctors or OB/GYNs.

How effective is a vasectomy?

Vasectomies are extremely effective as contraception and have a roughly 99.9% success rate.

How much does the procedure cost?

Below is a map with various Marion County health providers who perform vasectomies. The price listed is an estimate of the total cost for a person paying out of pocket. This cost includes the cost of the initial consultation, the vasectomy procedure, and the cost of the post-procedure semen analysis.

*If you have private insurance, Medicaid, or Medicare, the cost to you will vary based on your coverage.

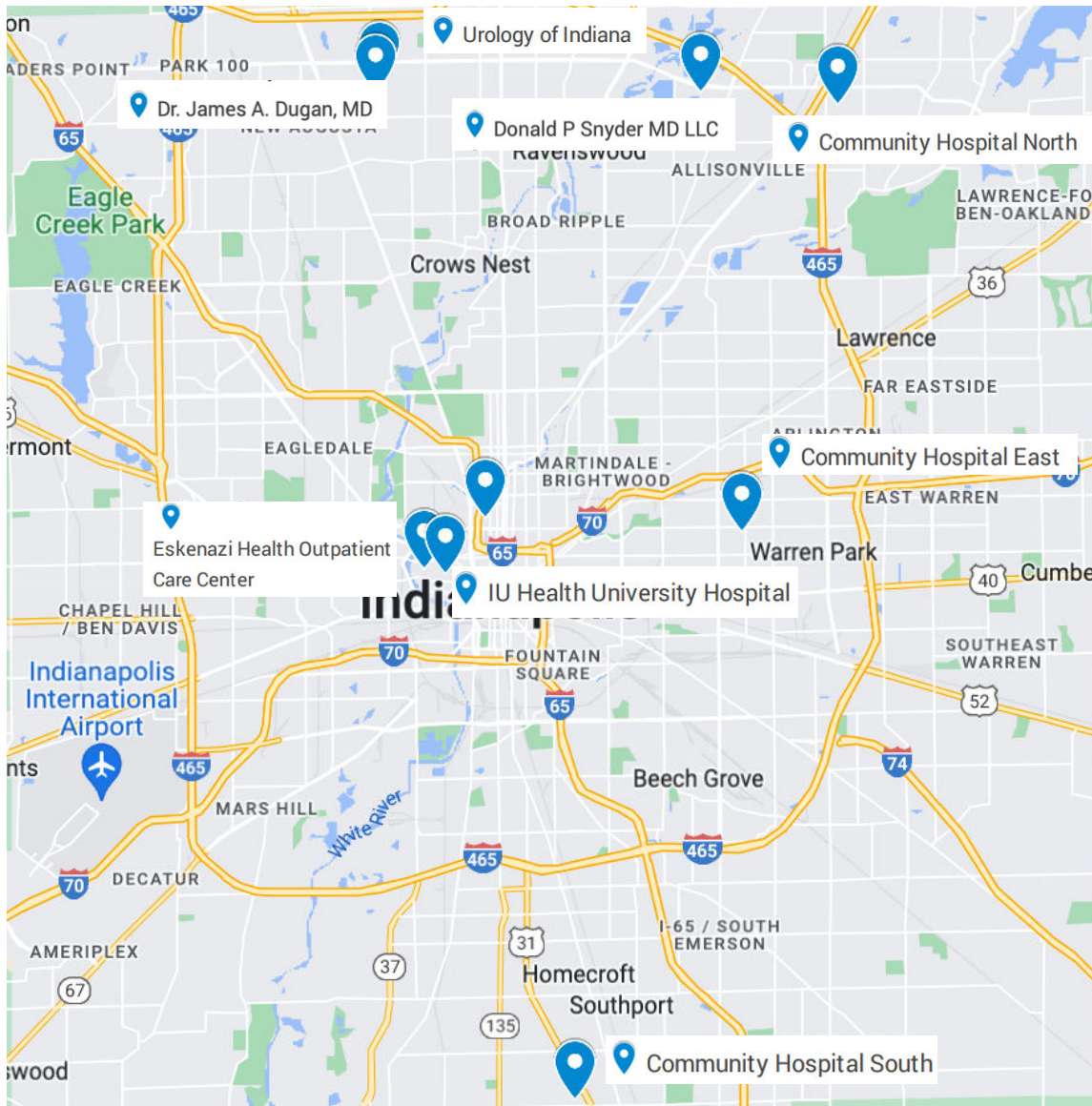
