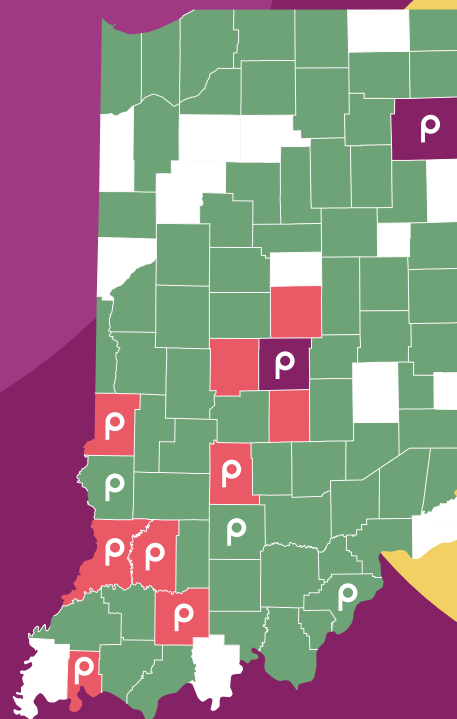
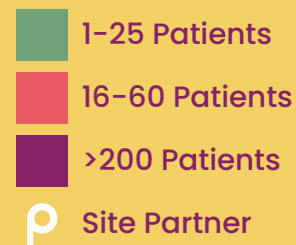


2024 End of Year Report

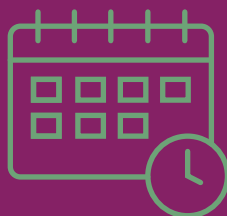
There are currently **19** partner sites with **8** in Marion county in addition to a statewide telehealth clinic. We have served patients from 84% of counties in the state.

New Free Emergency Contraception Program with over **1300+** orders in 7 months

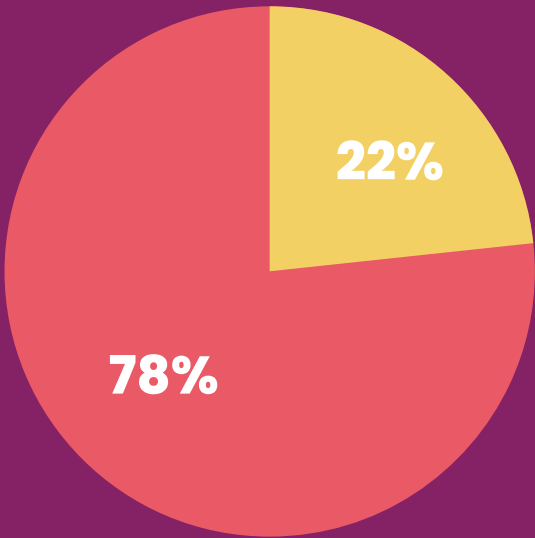

Served **2829** unique patients over **3838** visits

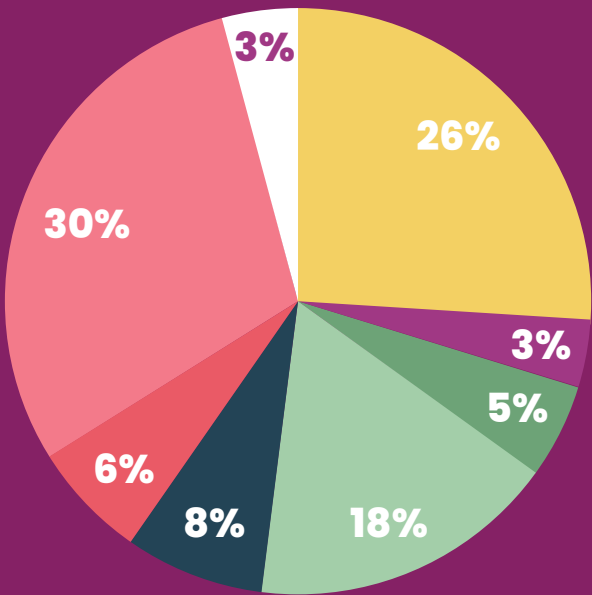
In 2024 we served **over 1203** unique patients over **1766** visits

Person-Centered Contraceptive Counseling

Person-centered contraceptive counseling (PCCC) is a validated measure focused on a patient’s needs and preferences by measuring the quality of care reported by the patient.
